January

Around the Home -

A Creative Image of Objects, Locations or happenings within the home property boundaries.

February

Liquid -

A picture of any type of Liquid either in its natural environment or combined with props.

March

Food -

Photo image of any type of food.

April

Still Life -

Still life is a work of art that focuses on inanimate subjects.

Usually, the subjects are commonplace objects. That can include both man made objects (such as vases, items of clothing, and consumer products) and natural objects (like plants, food, rocks, and shells).

May

Numbers -

An Image depicting numbers in a creative way.

June

Patterns -

A picture of an arrangement of subjects, shapes, or colour which is interesting or aesthetically pleasing to the eye of the viewer.

July

Photo Hunt -

Sunday, 4th July - To be advised

August

Negative Space -

Negative space is the area surrounding the main subject in a photograph which is left unoccupied.

Put simply, it is the space around the object itself that helps define the positive space, (or main focus)

September

Metal -

Anything goes other than METAL **MUST** be the dominant element or story of the photograph.

May be the whole picture of a metal object or part thereof.

October

Triptych -

Three images to tell a story. Can be 3 images in one frame, or 3 separate images.

November

Night Scene -

The image could be shots of the milky way, star trails or meteor shower.

Could also be a night time portrait or cityscape.
